

A Special Meeting of the Otsego City Commission was held Monday, May 27, 2019.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Trobeck at 8:30 a.m. with the following Commissioners present: Stacey Withee, Brent Milhiem, and Lauri Krueger. Absent: None.

**I. CONSIDERATIONS:**

**A. CONSIDERATION OF THE RESIGNATION OF COMMISSIONER NICK BREEDVELD**

Commissioner Milhiem moved to accept the resignation of Commissioner Breedveld, dated May 22, 2019, effective immediately, seconded by Commissioner Withee. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

**B. CONSIDERATION OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO PURCHASE REAL PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS 221 MITCHELL – VACANT LAND FROM NICK AND KARIN BREEDVELD**

Manager Mitchell explained that the signed purchase agreement indicated a closing date before May 31<sup>st</sup>, which was before the next City Commission Meeting, so a Special Meeting was needed. Commissioner Krueger moved to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to purchase real property commonly known as 221 Mitchell – vacant land from Nick and Karin Breedveld, seconded by Commissioner Withee. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
