A. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. PRESENTATION – PA 33 OF 1951

Mayor Trobeck presented a slide show to illustrate the current state-of-the City in regards to funding and how the City got to where it is financially today.

PA 33 of 1951, was explained as a financial means to create a special assessment district and the levying of mills to fund Police and Fire. The details of the special assessment district were discussed in detail.

One resident, Robert Alway was in attendance and the Commission answered his specific questions regarding PA 33.

At this time, the Commission discussed upcoming meetings and how the property owners will be informed of the Public Hearing scheduled for February 21, 2022.
