  - A. CONSIDERATION OF RECOMMENDATION TO THE CITY COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE SITE PLAN FOR 132 HELEN AVE LEWIS PITSCH

Member Mitchell gave a brief overview of the proposed site plan. He commented that this site plan is the first phase of a three-phase project. He stated that Lewis Pitsch owns both the old creamery and the old shoe factory. He gave a brief history of the buildings. He stated that the buildings will be: (1) 30X60 and (3) 30X40, each will have a small office space with a bathroom, and three parking spaces. Member Mitchell stated that the use will be for light industrial and the site plan meets all of the specifications. He noted that there is a natural barrier of trees on the west side of the property buffering it from the residential area. He answered questions of the Planning Commission regarding the size of trucks using the proposed site; required green space; and fire hydrant placement.
